81.0 <u>REPORTS FROM DISTRICT & COUNTY COUNCILLORS & POLICE</u> SDDC Councillor Whittenham reported:

At the Area Forum meeting held at Hilton it reported that "Crash for cash" has been occurring on the A50 Toyota roundabout recently. Police are investigating. Xmas refuse collection dates are on the SDDC website.

Faraday bags which you can place your car keys in to protect from car thieves are available from SDDC via the website.

SDDC Councillor asked if councillors were happy for elections to be held in school and would it be convenient to hold in the Methodist Chapel. Clerk advised that the school had advised SDDC they were happy for the election to continue in school and preparations are already being organised. Councillor Spalton suggested that as we do not know if the Methodist Chapel Schoolroom will continue to be available it may be prudent to continue at the school at present.

Councillors asked if the free tree scheme was still operating but were advised that it ceased at the end of October.

Councillor Patten has offered to fund a replacement tree for the land outside school. Councillor Whittenham advised that SDDC would be allocating possible wildflower grass verge sites. Councillors asked if there were any free seeds for the wildflower grass verges and if possible, could the Parish Council have some for the "Reading Room Bank".

Parish Councillors advised that SDDC are no longer issuing paper copies of planning applications but due to Church Broughton Parish Council not having a meeting room with internet and poor home internet connection for Councillors, SDDC have agreed to continue issuing paper copies for a short while.

The Parish Council had not been advised of the planning application DMPA/2019/1205 at Dove Valley. Councillor Whittenham and Clerk to peruse. Clerk to ask for an extension.

Mr Weil advised that the Methodist Circuit are preparing to place the Chapel and Schoolroom up for sale if the community do not proceed with the lease.
